

Free Room Entry Operator 2-Day Certification Program Open to Law Enforcement: Federal, State, County, Local, and Military Operators

A two-day certification-training course, on June 17 -18, 2010, will focus on training in tactical room entry and clearing techniques using variations of speed and angles. Participants will increase movement and entry skills while submersed in a real-world situations environment. Given the current trends of active-shooter responses in large facilities, as well as entries into smaller structures, this program will provide operators the ability to conduct various entry methods scenarios while not being locked down to “one way” method of conducting entries. In addition, the Room Entry program will provide operators multiple ways of making entries and clearing threat locations with more confidence. Emphasis will be put on operator conditioning, mindset, and thinking skills while applying his/her tactics when entering a room.

- Room entry techniques for slow methodical or dynamic style entries
- Various pre-entry signals
- Back clear techniques
- Threat engagement utilizing Force Option™ techniques
- Confrontation simulations
- Close quarter battle in confined quarters

Live, hands-on training will occur using the [RATPAC™](#) (Reconfigurable Armored Tactical Personnel And Collective) training system. The system provides the perfect scenario for force-option training including breach door entry and room clearing.
